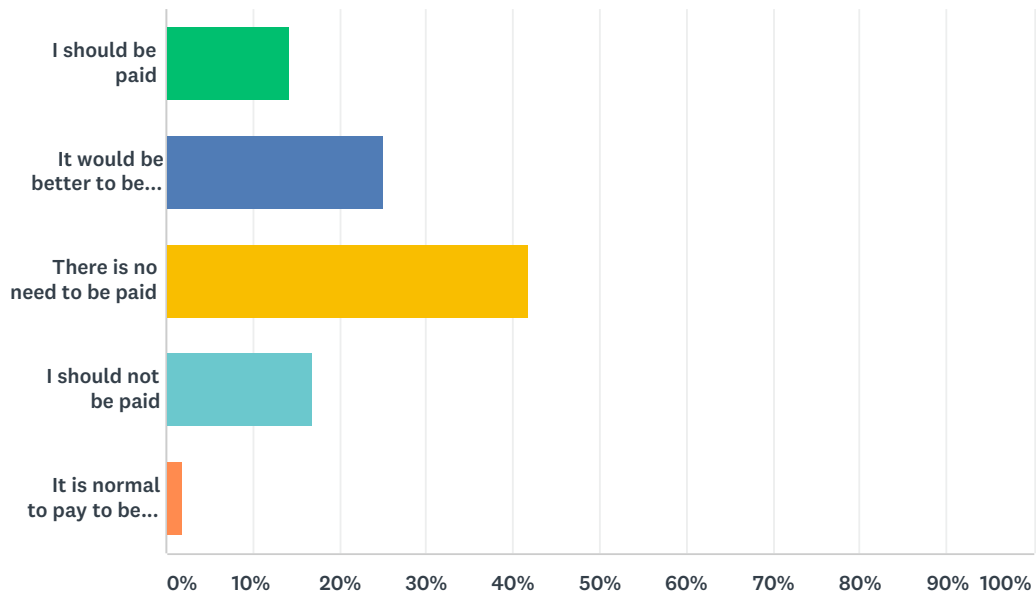

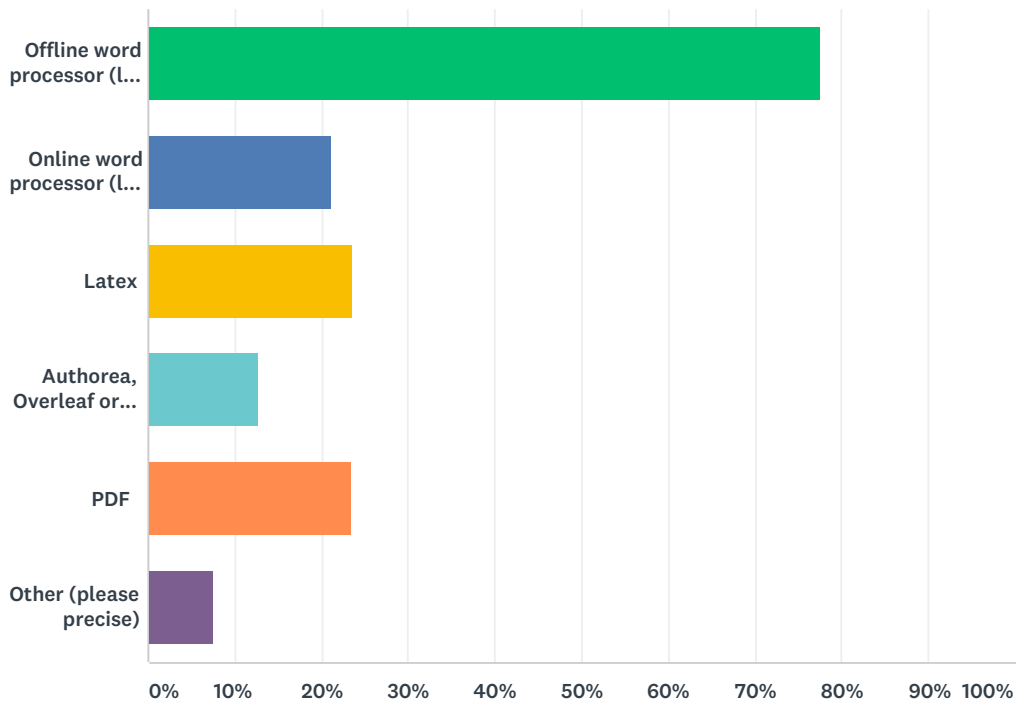

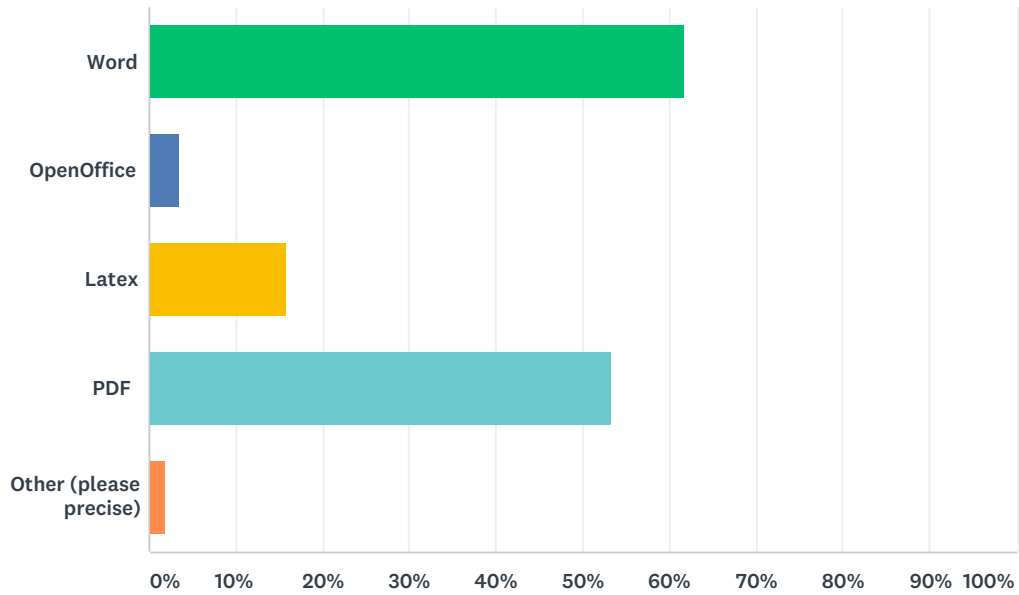

Q4 What is the usual format that you use to submit article ?

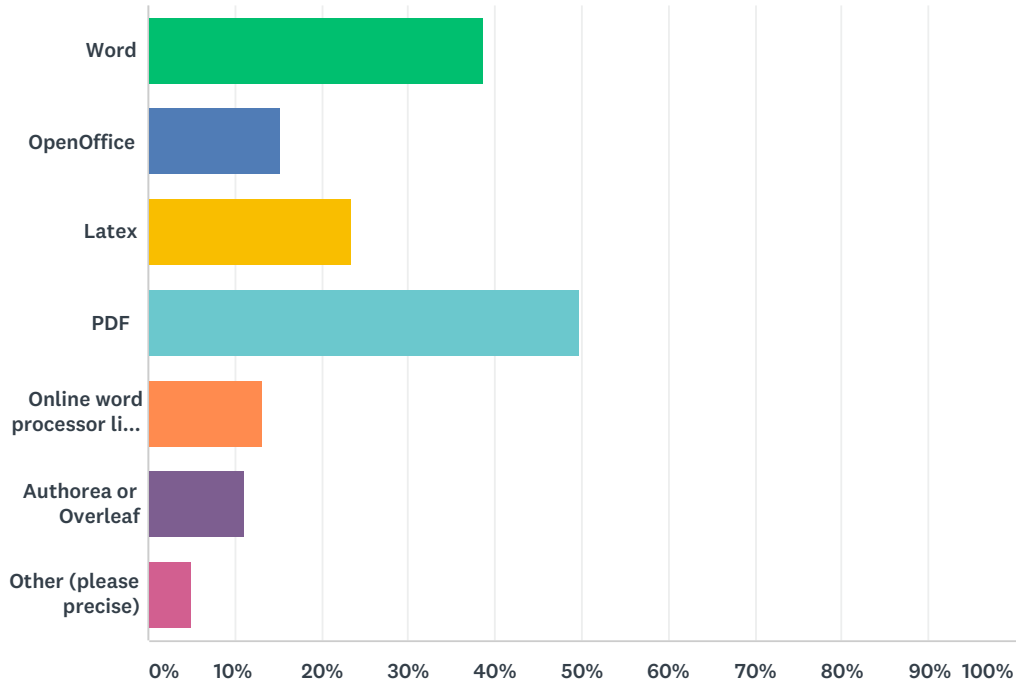

Q5 What would be an ideal format to submit article?

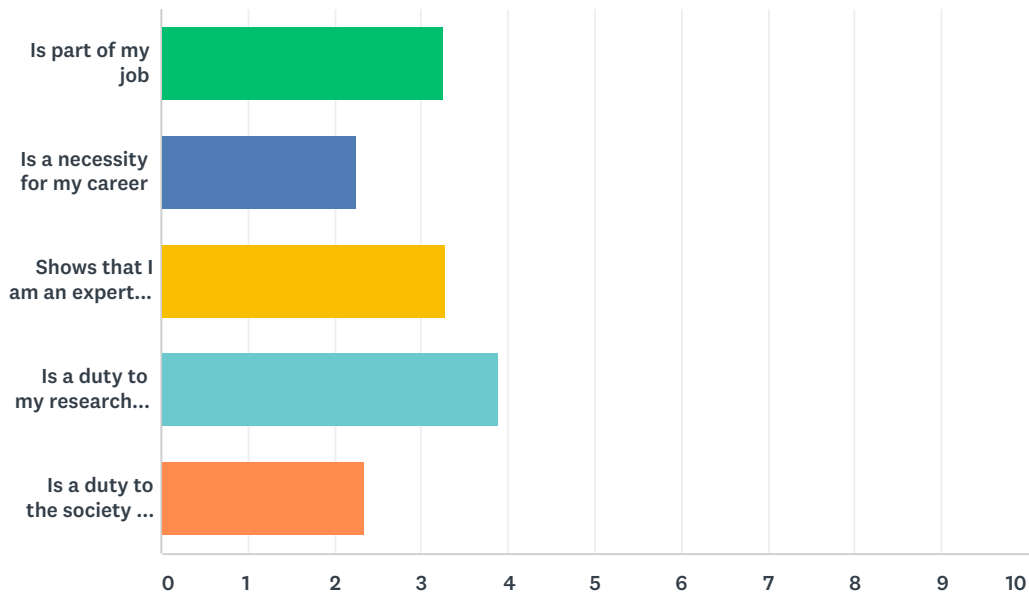

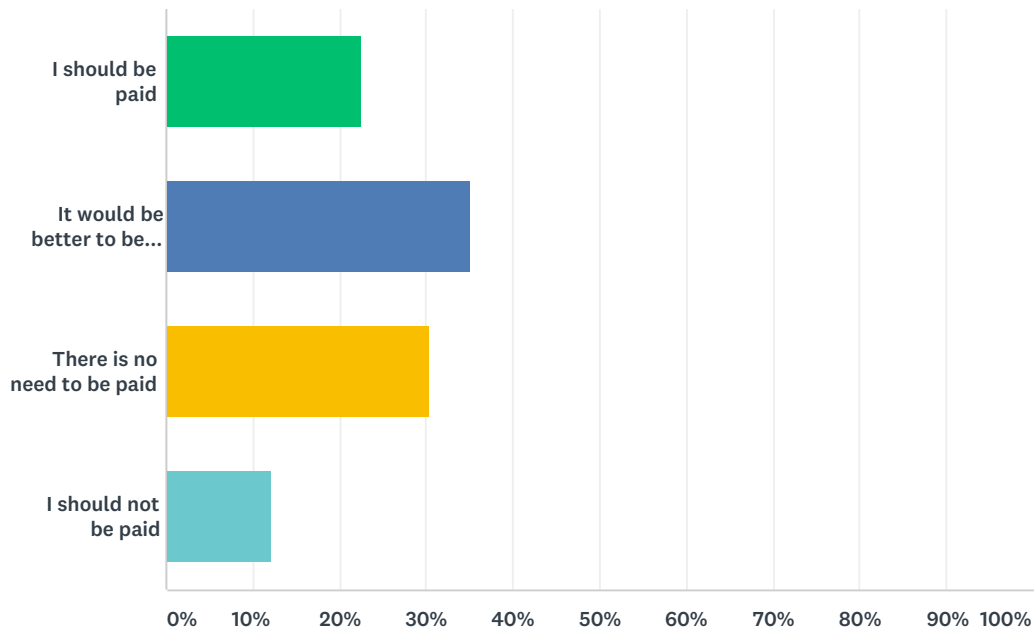

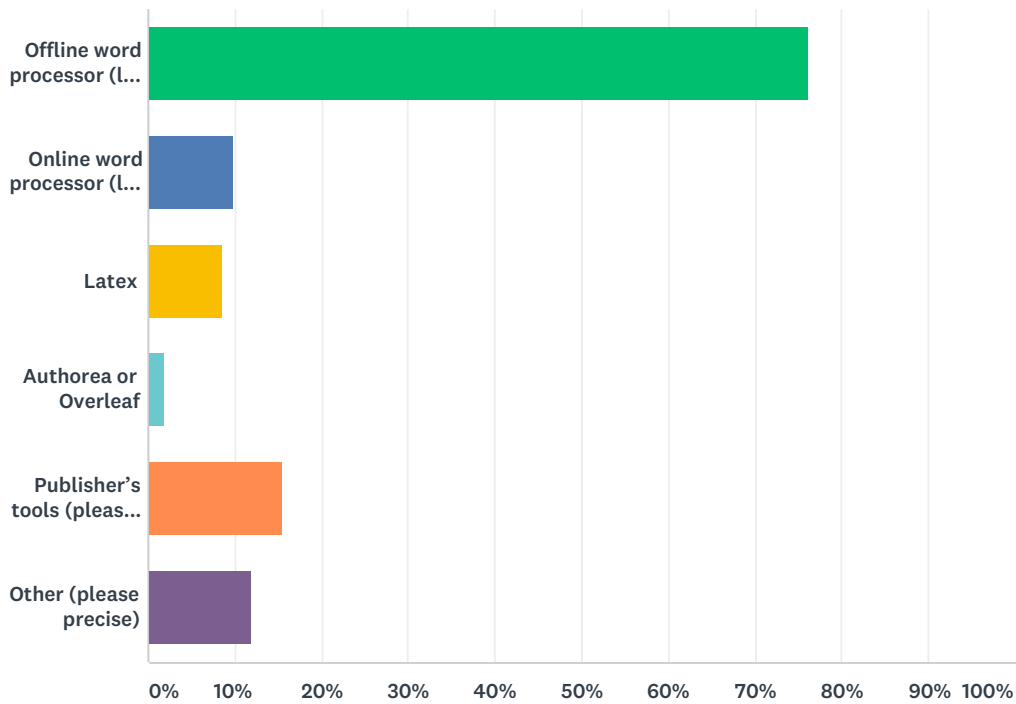

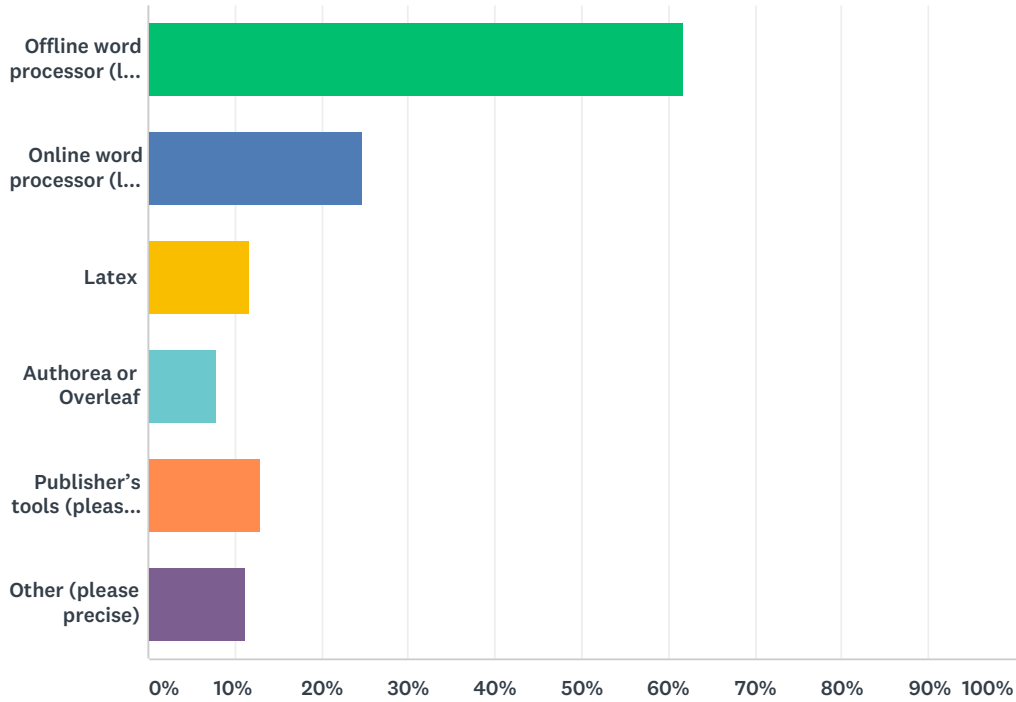

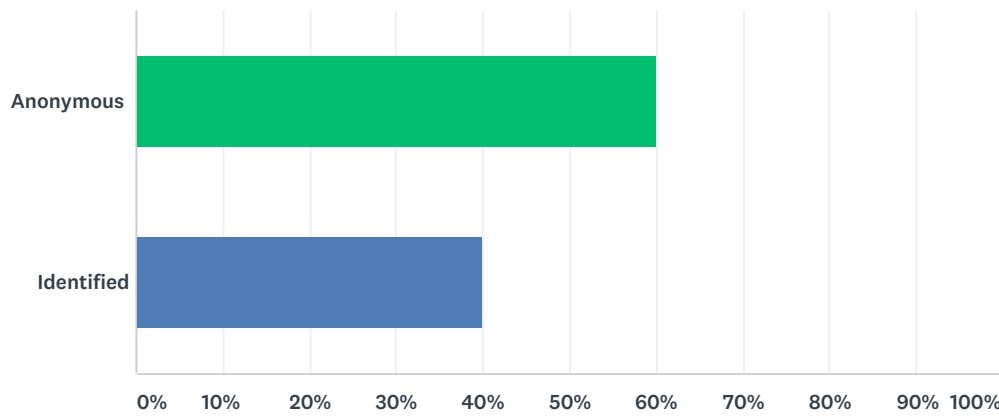

Q10 Should peer-reviewer be anonymous or identified?

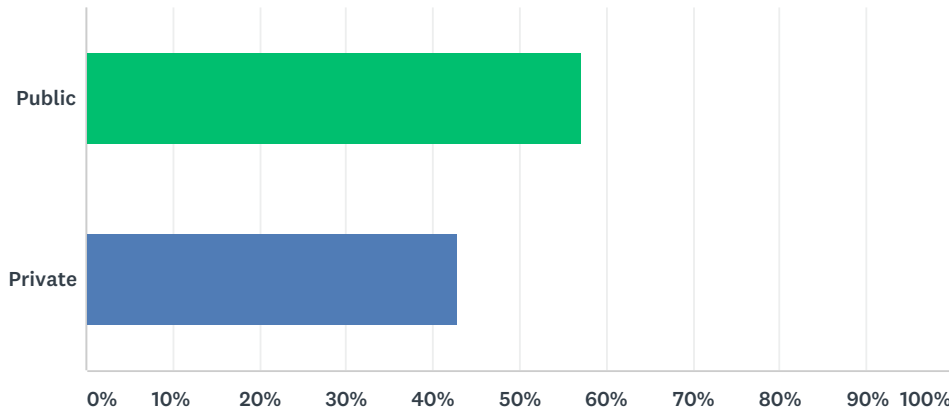

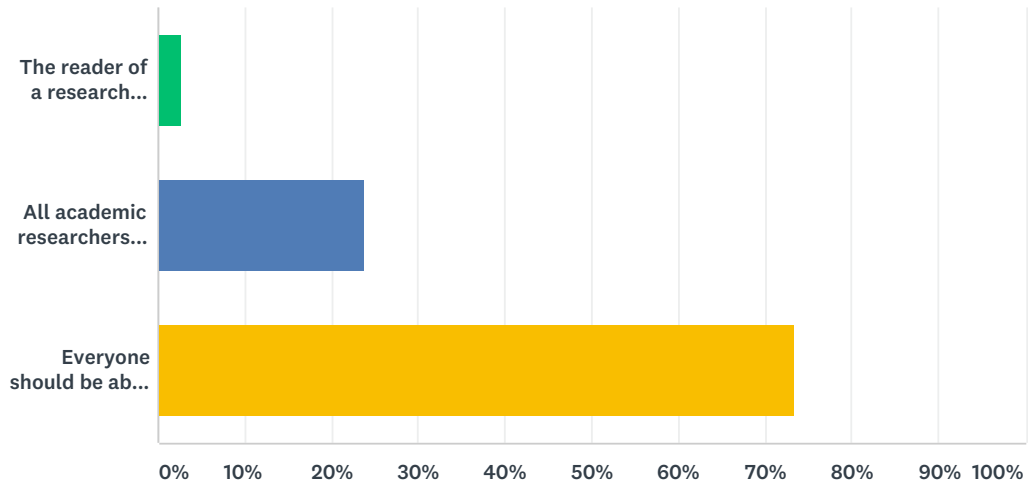

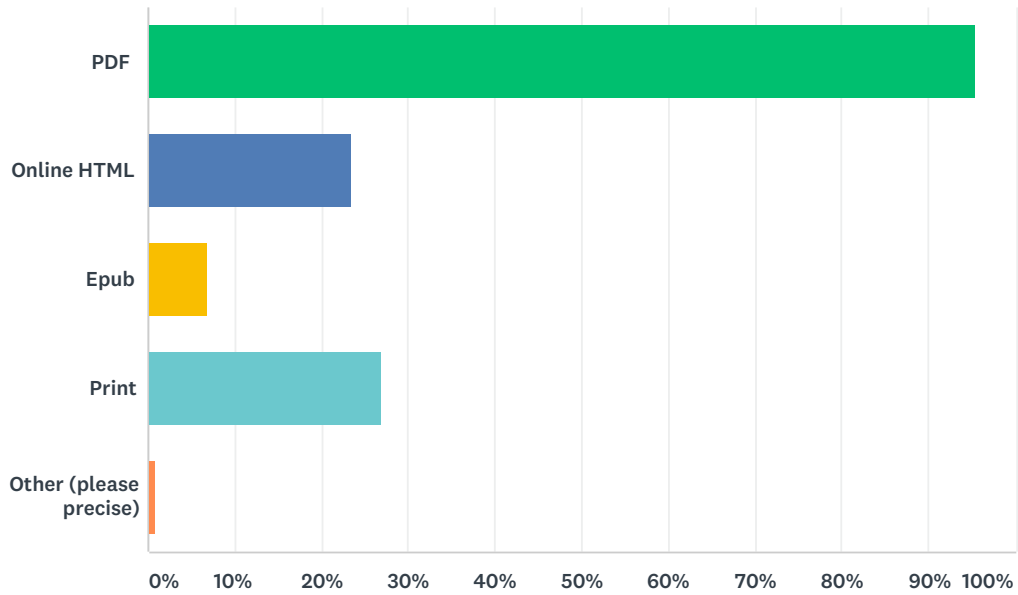

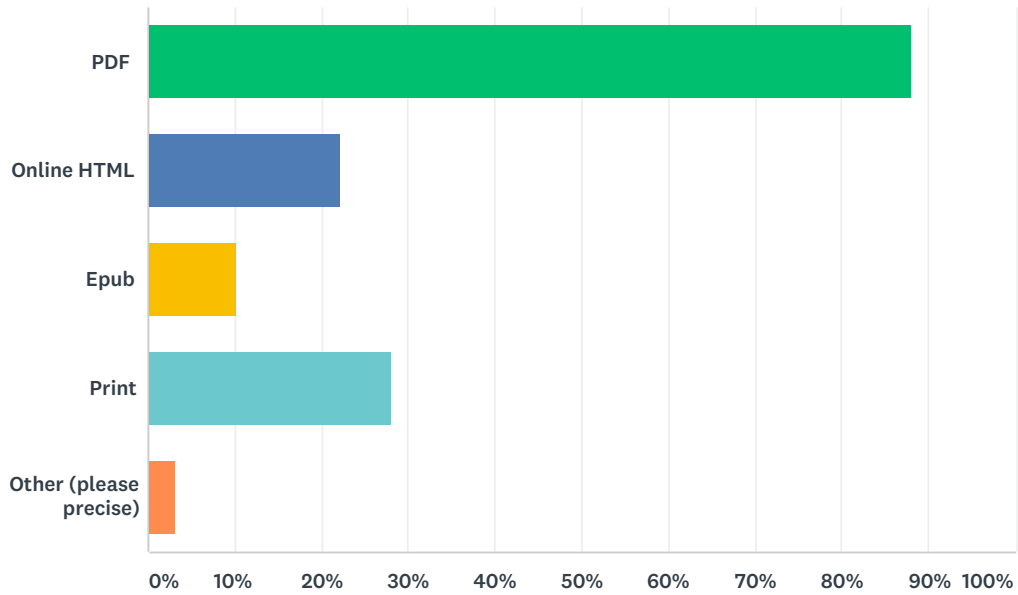

Q14 What format would you ideally use to read your articles.

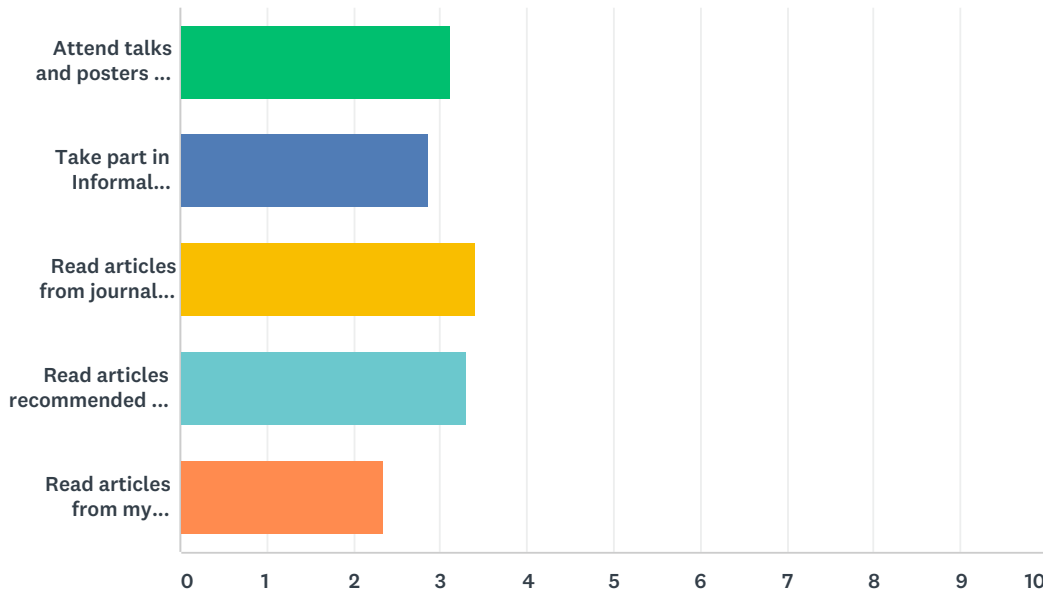

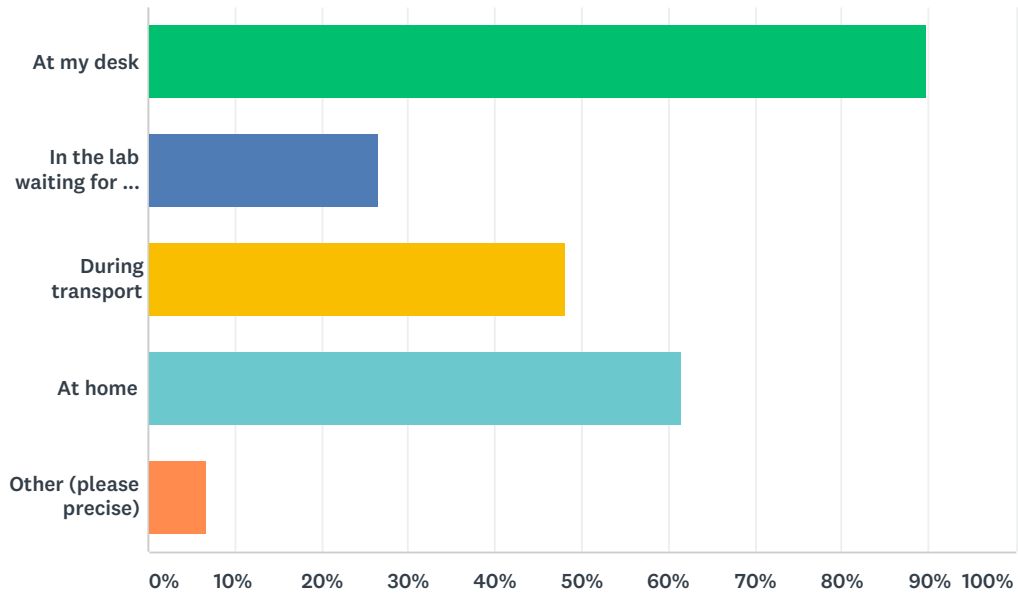

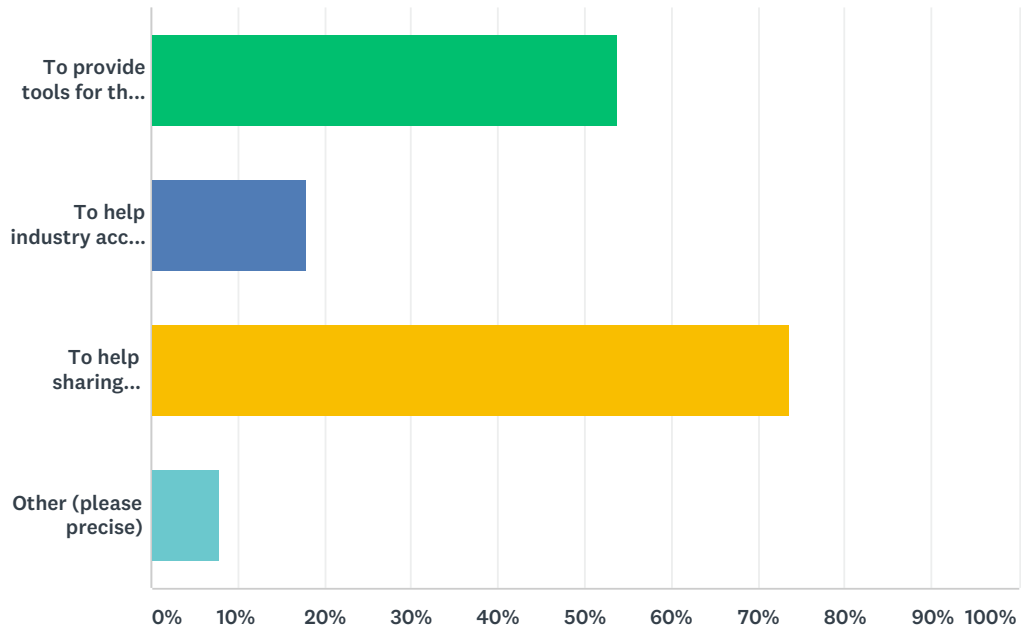

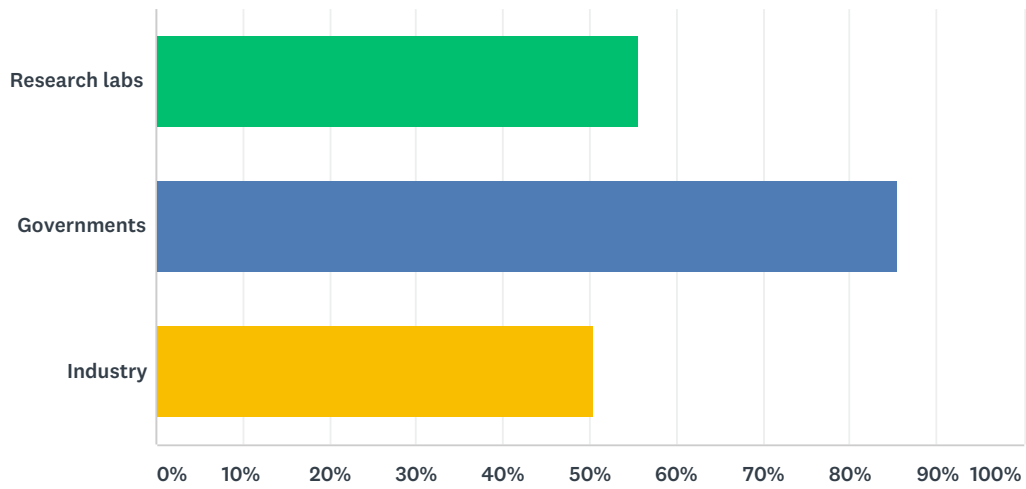

Q18 Which of the following categories should take part of the funding of the scholarly publication:

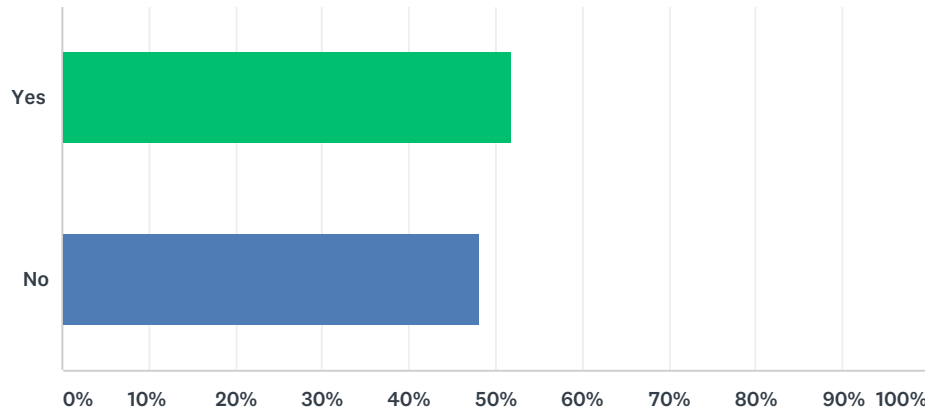

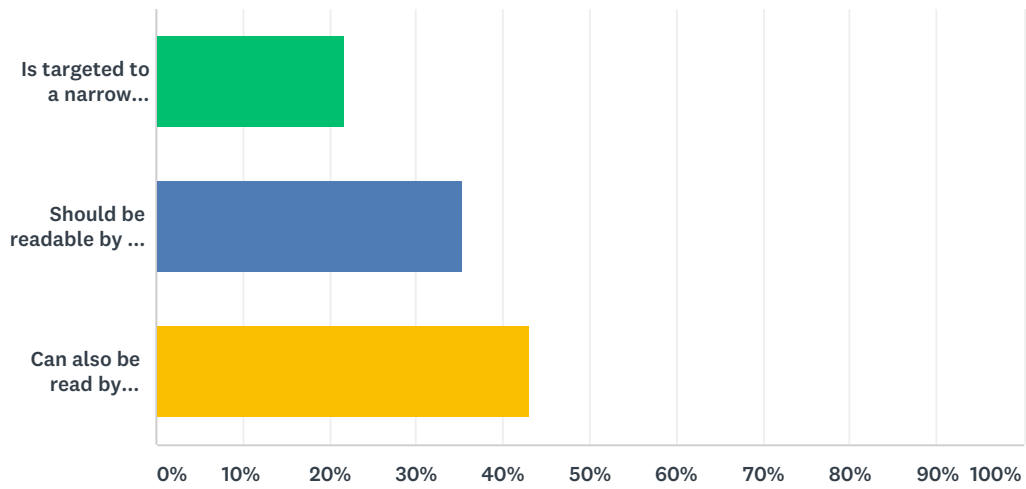

Q21 Which of the following statements do you feel closest to “a research article...” ?

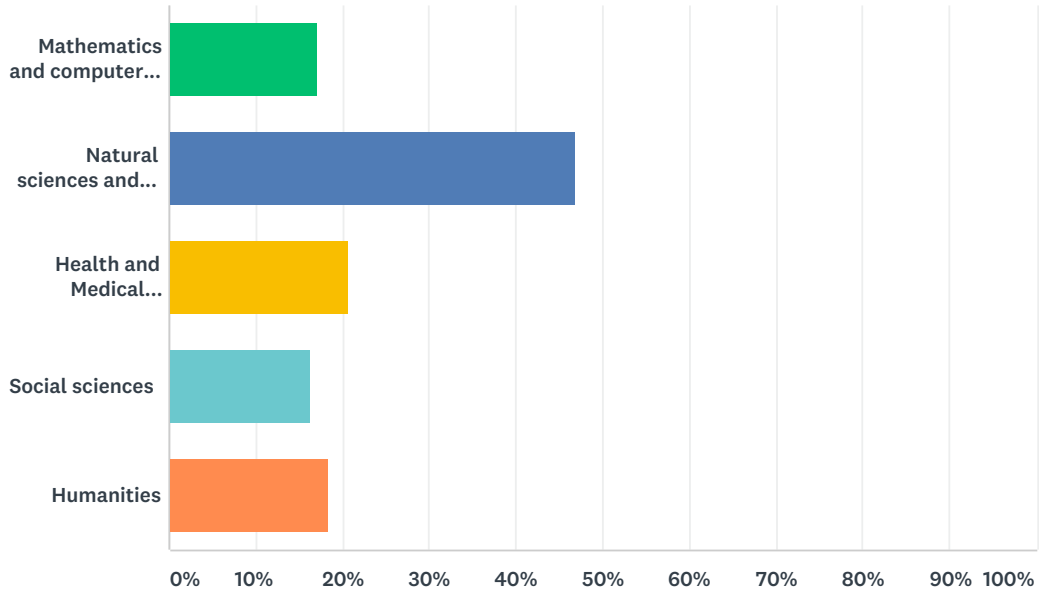

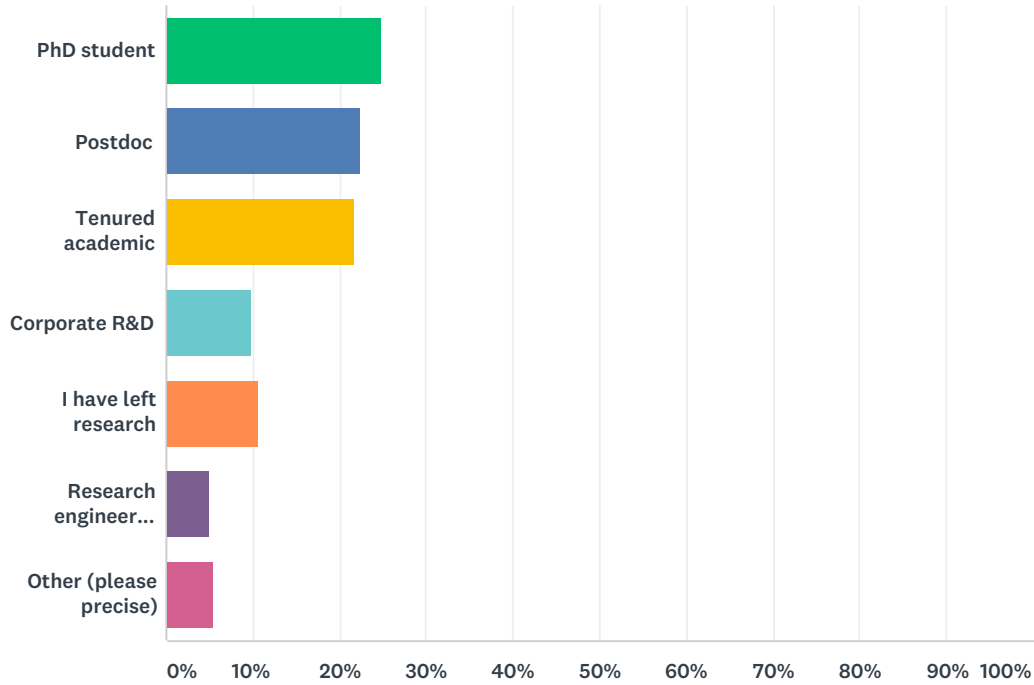

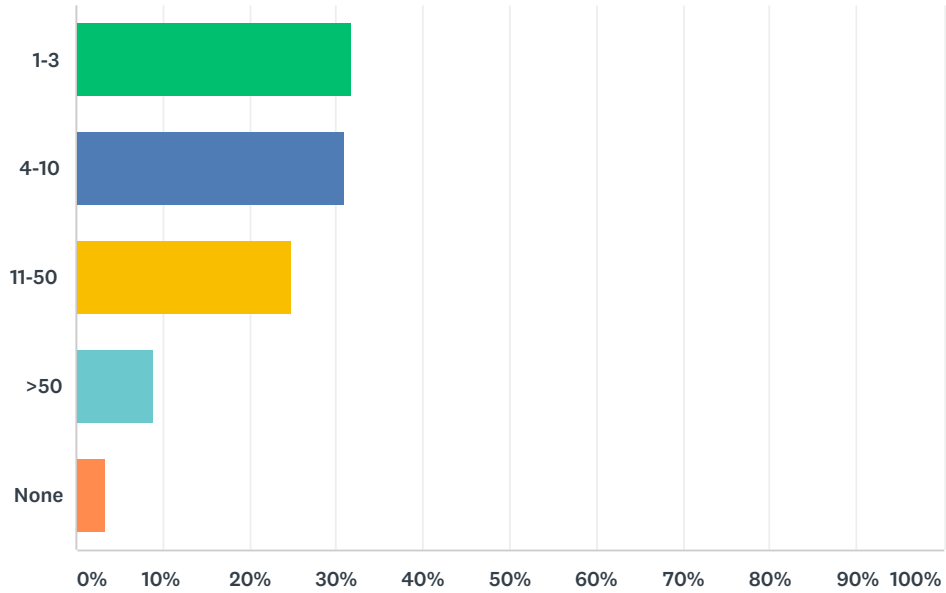

Q25 How many research articles have you co-authored in total?

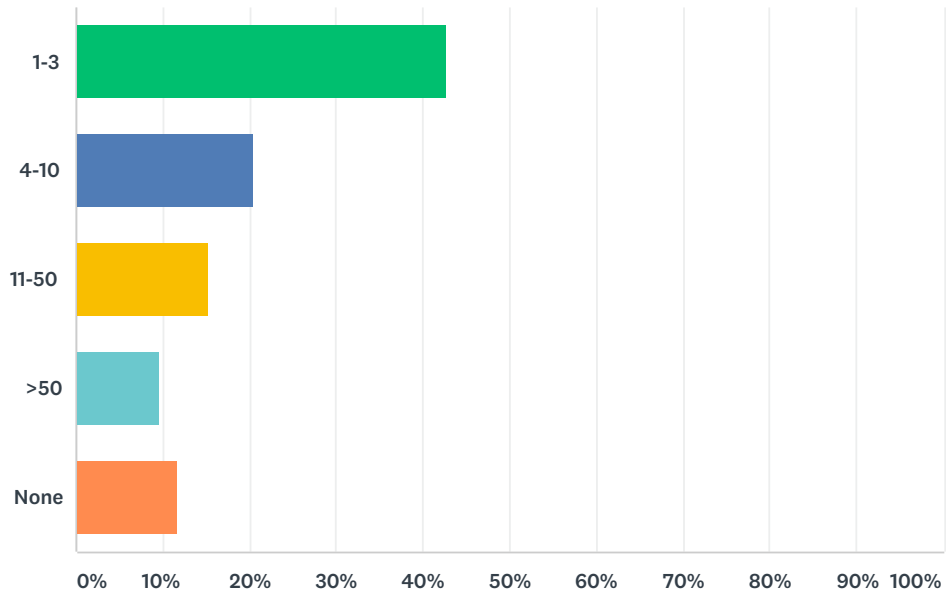

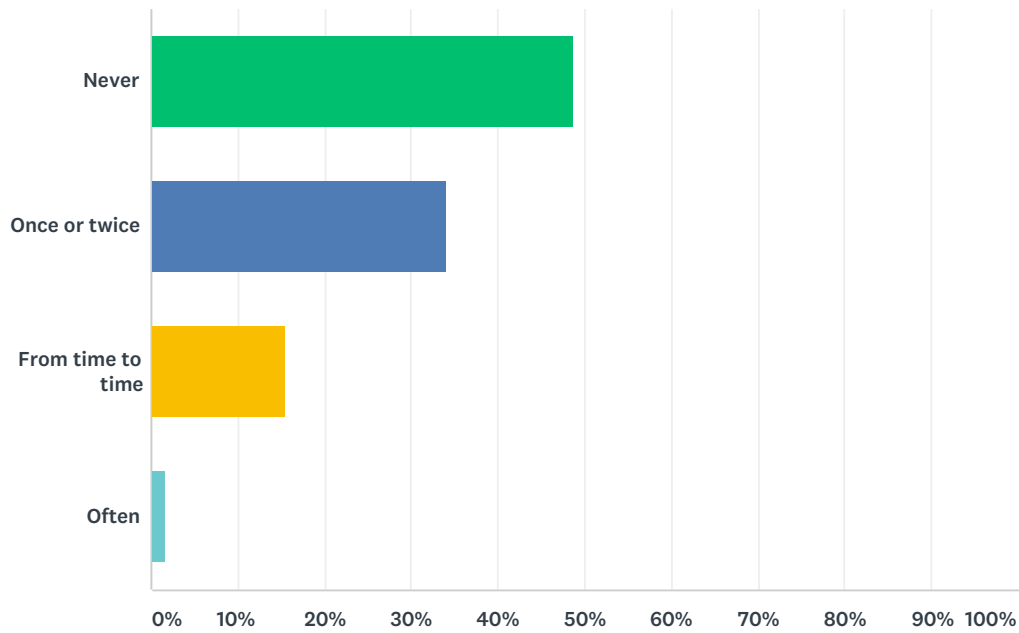

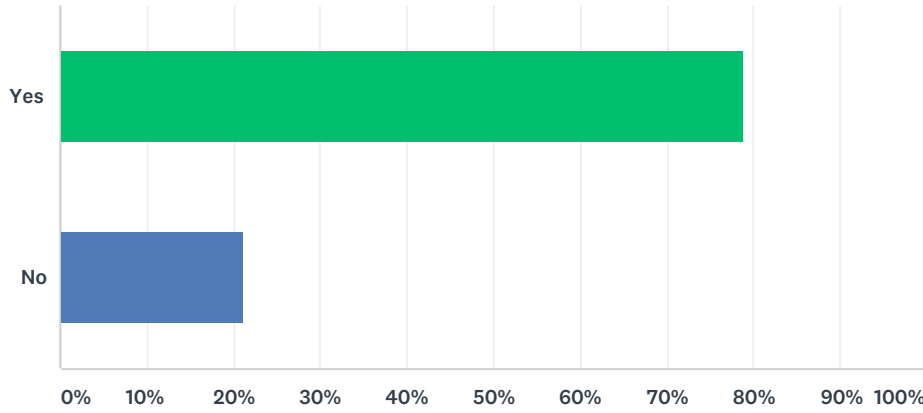

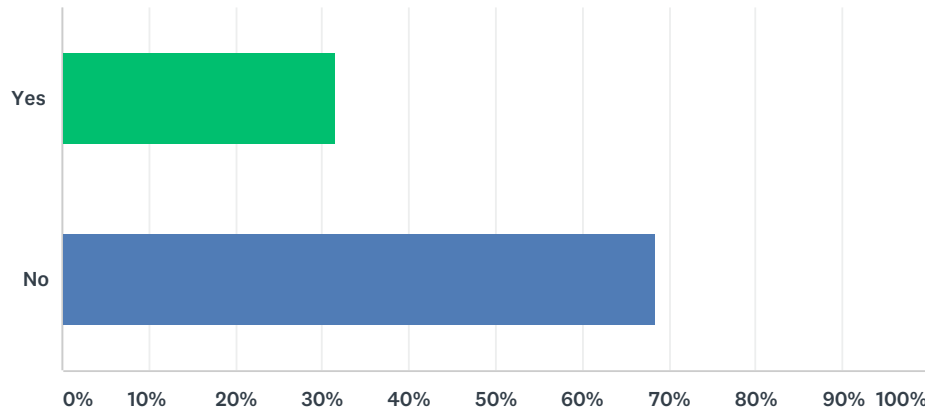
